## **CCL Launches Centenary Year with House of Lords Celebration**

The Commonwealth Countries League (CCL) officially kicked off its Centenary Year (1925-2025) with an inspiring Afternoon Tea at the House of Lords on 22 May, hosted by The Rt. Hon. Lord David Hunt of Wirral.

The event welcomed high-profile guests including the Commonwealth Secretary-General, Rt. Hon. Shirley Ayorkor Botchwey, and dignitaries from across 56 nations. In her keynote speech, the Secretary-General praised CCL's commitment to girls' education and gender equality, calling it "a foundation for a more equitable and prosperous society."

With music by saxophonist Paula Juden and charming hosting by Dale Eaton, the event blended tribute and celebration. CCL President Duchess Williams-Alonga reaffirmed the League's mission: "This centenary celebrates our past and energizes our commitment to empowering girls for a better future."
